RDA Illawarra has strongly advocated for shovel-ready infrastructure projects for our region, working with local governments as well as the private sector.

From major capital investments through to small community infrastructure projects, we have brought together regional stakeholders and advocated to governments to support investments.

We also developed a shovel-ready assessment methodology in consultation with regional stakeholders, presenting three different options to the federal government for consideration.






Supported Destination Wollongong's Visitor Economy Program

RDA Illawarra supported Destination Wollongong's Visitor Economy Support Program

The tourism sector was just starting to recover post Bushfires and was then hit with COVID-19. This left them significantly disadvantaged and many in the visitor economy are small and micro businesses.

We worked with Destination Wollongong, KPMG and Destination Sydney South Surrounds to support the development of a tailored program to help tourism-affected businesses with financial and marketing expertise to aid their recovery.

This program is currently being delivered to tourism-related businesses in the Wollongong LGA.

The Visitor Economy Support Program has been designed to offer immediate, practical assistance to local small businesses.



Developed a COVID-19 Illawarra Regional Economic Recovery Plan



Activity: Evidence-based intelligence to Government

We have developed a COVID-19 Illawarra Regional Economic Regional Recovery Plan. Working in collaboration with Illawarra industry, peak bodies, local governments, ISJO and the Illawarra Regional Recovery Task Force. This plan is strongly evidence-based on data however the analysis is being done in a highly volatile economic and COVID-19 health context.

This long-term regional plan approaches our recovery over three stages, Rescue, Recovery and Renaissance, and is an iterative/living plan which aims to address the differing challenges we face in the Illawarra region. We have provided the draft plan to The Hon Nola Marino, Assistant Minister for Regional Development Assistant Minister for Regional Development and Territories.

Minister Marino has commended RDA Illawarra and thanked the board and team, led by Chair Eddy de Gabriele, for our engagement with businesses and all levels of Government as vital in identifying emerging issues throughout the crisis and opportunities for the recovery phase.

Regional Certifying Body for Skilled Migration Program

Activity: Evidence-based intelligence to Government



RDA Illawarra is now the Regional Certifying Body RCB for the Skilled Employer Sponsored Regional (SESR) (Provisional) (subclass 494) for the Illawarra region. The Program assists employers in regional and low population growth areas of Australia where they have been unable to fill vacant positions with Australian citizens or permanent residents living in or wishing to move to the Illawarra region where the nominated position is located.

The role of a RCB is to provide advice to the Department of Home Affairs (DoHA) on the SESR visa, ES stream nomination applications, using local area knowledge to advise on whether the nominee for the position will be paid at least the annual market salary rate for the occupation.
