Australian Red Cross - National Registration and Inquiry System

If you have been evacuated please register with the relevant evacuation centre. This helps emergency services know that you are safe. NRIS registers, finds and reunites family, friends and loved ones after an emergency. It is managed and operated by Australian Red Cross. People evacuated in an emergency (or people trying to locate family or friends) can phone the Red Cross Inquiry Centre on 1800 727 077 for callers in Australia or international callers on +61 393 283991.
