RDA Illawarra Chair Eddy De Gabriele, Deputy Chair Joanna Kubota and CEO Debra Murphy attended the RDA 2021 National Forum in Canberra on 15 - 17 June and had the opportunity to connect with politicians in Parliament House including The Hon. Senator Concetta Fierravanti-Wells, Stephen Jones, the Hon. Michael McCormack, the Hon. Barnaby Joyce and the Hon. Nola Marino.

The National Forum, hosted by The Hon. Nola Marino MP, Assistant Minister for Regional Development and Territories, provided an opportunity for RDAs from across Australia to strengthen connections, network and learn from experts in the field of regional economic development.

This year's theme was Growing Stronger Regions together with sessions that focused on regionalisation, the role of infrastructure and financing, growing economic futures and vertical integrated policy-making.



Illawarra windfall in Federal Budget \$275m for roads and energy largest in over a decade

Big Budget Boost for the Illawarra

Energy & Roads to benefit from investment bonanza as Federal Government invests \$275m in the region.





- \$30 million for proposed Port Kembla power station Australian Industrial Power's (AIP) plan to build a 635 MW hydrogen-ready gas fired power station at Port Kembla.
- \$5 million for Tallawarra 'B' project
 Energy Australia propose to expand capacity on the existing site.

40% of City Deal Projects funded in 8 months (\$352.2m)

There were some great wins this quarter for the Illawarra-Shoalhaven City Deal Collaborative, demonstrating our achievements from working together for the regions.

Picton Road and Mt Ousley Interchange comprise a major transport connection between the region and rapidly expanding Western Sydney. The provision of \$344M for these projects is a welcome funding injection from the NSW and Australian Governments.

On 4 June, RDA Illawarra were pleased to host Greater Sydney Commission representatives Liz Dibbs (Western City District Commissioner), Jackie Taranto (Economic Commissioner) and Elizabeth Mildwater (CEO) for a tour of the Port of Port Kembla, BlueScope and surrounding industrial land areas. RDA Illawarra Board members Mark Roberts, Joanna Kubota and Linda Davis also attended the visit.

A briefing and discussion with the Greater Sydney Commission and Illawarra stakeholders, including Cardno, centred on the activation of the Port of Port Kembla Precinct, the <u>Illawarra-Shoalhaven City Deal</u> and the Southern Container Intermodal Rail Terminal.

We look forward to continuing to interact with the Greater Sydney Commission on connectivity between the Illawarra and Western Sydney.
