Illawarra-Shoalhaven City Deal achieves 54% funding

The Illawarra-Shoalhaven City Deal has now achieved 54% of target funding in just 20 months since its launch in October 2020.

Recently started projects that were part of the 2020 Illawarra-Shoalhaven City Deal Prospectus have received total funding of over \$470M.

The diverse range of transformative regional initiatives include funding for planning a rejuvenated Illawarra Sports & Entertainment Precinct, the construction of waste recovery and landfill reduction facility in the Shoalhaven and further planning funds for Picton Road connecting to Western Sydney.



Illawarra Sports & Entertainment Precinct Business Case funding provided in NSW Budget

RDA Illawarra has long supported the development of the Illawarra Sports & Entertainment Precinct (ISEP), along with the region's Peak Bodies. Our advocacy work has been ongoing and included recent correspondence to the NSW Treasurer and Minister for Tourism & Sport, on behalf of the Peak Bodies.

We congratulate Wollongong City Council on their recent report and Business Illawarra on their report which contributed to our collaborative advocacy for ISEP.

In June 2022, the NSW Government announced \$3.5 million in the budget (\$4.5 million recurrent expenses over two years) to develop a detailed business case and Master Plan for ISEP.

We welcomed this announcement and look forward to working with Venues NSW, the NSW Government and our Peak Bodies to deliver a business case which will enable development of a thriving regional visitor economy and jobs growth.


